To the Senale and House of Representatives in Congress assembled.

The memorial of a number of the inhabitants of that track of Country Situate between the chiami rivers, and North of a tract of land granted by tellers patent to John Cleves Symmes and his afsociates, most respectfully shewith That we your memorialists, from many circumstances, had reasonable grounds to believe, that the above named M. Symmes had contracted with the United States for the lands on which we are selled, and that he would obtain a tille for the same, under which impression we became purchasers and many of us Traid the purchase money in full, and sundry of us at a period much carlier than his obtaining the letters patent aforesaid. many of us migrated with our families immediately after the termination of The Indian War under all the disadvantages incident to such a . erisis, since that, much of the money remaining a fler payment for our lands has been expended, and the whole of our labour employed in cleating the wilderness, and making such other improvements as the wants and conveniences of Society require, among which Roads and Mills have been subjects of much labour and expense, for several years we felt seeme and labound with chearfulness, not was it until Sume one Thous and seven hundred and nevery sine that we were fully convinced that M? Symmes claim was held as a nutlity, when the det of Congress reached us quanting the right of fireimplien to purchasers of certain descriptions. Our situation a year ago induced us to forward an address to your Honourable body by the Gentleman delegated to Represent the Scrittory in Congress, as we have not obtained the relief we prayed for in that ift we do not give over sait, but firmly relying in the equily and Bounty of congress trust that our case will be taken into consideration early in the ensuing stepsion, and that the question will be determined whether we can apply without further waste of time to Mr. summes for our tilles or a wimbursement of our monics. Should Mr Symmes not obtain a patent we trust that all of us who hold under his

claim, until one thousand seven hundred and runety nine will obtain a fue emption right upon the same lerms on which M. Symm night have held the same had he complied with the terms of his original contract. Our lands we purchased agreeable to a partial. Survey which had been made of the track, the meridional lines being run only and each miles end monumented which was de-Signed to supply the place of East and west fines being run by de. from one monument to its correspondent one on its adjacent meridion now should a resurvey be made it is probable that a considerable variation will happen in the lines, therefore we trust that this subject will merit the attention of congress, and such provisions he made as will quiet us in the possession of the land we actually purchased, independant of whatever alteration be may be occafioned by a resurvey. The foregoing is the setuation of your memorialists, to whom your Honourable body will calend much relief as the mouts of Their case may re quic, and They shall be. October 22 d. 1800.
